## YOUR fares and tickets from 2 January 2007

From 2 January 2007, there are some changes to fares and tickets for the bus, Tube, tram and Docklands Light Railway (DLR).

We are pleased to announce that Oyster is the cheapest way to travel around London and that, from Easter 2007, travel for Under-11s on the **Tube and DLR** is FREE all day with an Under-14 Oyster photocard.

This leaflet contains further information on Oyster single fares, Oyster daily price capping, cash single fares and other tickets within the Greater London area.

## Key information for YOUR London travel

### The benefits of paying by Oyster:

- Cash **bus and tram** single fares cost £2 but with Oyster are £1 at all times
- The adult daily cap for unlimited travel on **buses and trams** is frozen at £3
- Single adult cash **Tube** fares within zone 1 cost £4 but with Oyster remain at £1.50
- The adult daily cap for unlimited travel with pay as you go remains 50p less than the cost of the equivalent Day Travelcard
- A single fare for Under-16s on the **Tube and DLR** is 50p per journey with a daily cap of £1 for unlimited travel

## Using YOUR Oyster

To make sure you pay the correct fare for your journey, you must always touch in (by touching your Oyster card flat on the reader) at the start of your journey and touch out at the end of your Tube journey. Failure to touch in and out correctly will result in you being charged the maximum cash fare for your Tube journey.

When using Oyster to pay as you go on the DLR you will need to touch in and touch out at the start and end of your journey. Failure to touch in and out correctly will result in you being charged the maximum cash fare.

If you are charged the maximum cash fare, it will not count towards your daily price cap.

When using a bus or tram, you need to touch in at the start of your journey.

Please check for the green light when you touch in and/or out to ensure your Oyster card has been validated. Failure to touch in and/or out may result in a penalty fare or you being prosecuted.

If you do not hold a valid ticket, Travelcard or have enough cash to pay as you go for your entire journey you may receive a penalty fare or be prosecuted.

Oyster daily price capping

**Using Oyster to pay as you go on Tube, DLR and some National Rail services** (includes use on bus and tram services).

As you travel around, the system checks and keeps a running total of each journey you make, ensuring that when the cap is reached, you always pay 50p less than the equivalent Day Travelcard for journeys that start within the 24 hour period from 0430 and before 0430 the next morning. Some journeys have been defined as requiring travel via Zone 1 and will be charged and capped accordingly, irrespective of the actual route taken. Peak times are 0430-0930 Monday to Friday (except Public Holidays). Off-Peak is at all other times.

Tube/DLR – Train cash fares

Tube/DLR – Train fares cover journeys between the Tube/DLR and National Rail and from National Rail to National Rail via the Tube/DLR, and are the maximum you will pay for a single/return journey in the London zonal area. Oyster single fares on National Rail

National Rail only allows customers to pay as you go on the following services:

- Richmond to Gunnersbury
- Stratford to Liverpool Street
- Stratford to Tottenham Hale/Seven Sisters
- Upminster to Fenchurch Street/Liverpool Street via Barking (but not at Forest Gate/Maryland)
- West Ruislip/South Ruislip to Marylebone (but not at intermediate stations)

Tube/DLR cash single, return and Group Day tickets on National Rail

Travelcards can be used on the Tube, DLR, tram and National Rail<sup>†</sup> within the zones covered by your ticket and on all London Buses displaying this sign:



They also include a 1/3 discount off scheduled Riverboat services.

Only Travelcards covering zones 3,4,5 or 6 are valid on trams.

Combines one day’s travel on DLR with hop-on, hop-off travel on City Cruises riverboats between Westminster, Waterloo, Tower and Greenwich piers. Buy tickets at any City Cruises pier, the Ticket Stop at Tower Gateway, at London City Airport or Canary Wharf station.

Free travel is available for:

- under 14 year olds
- 11-13 year olds using the tram at Wimbledon with an Under-14 or Child Oyster photocard
- 14-15 year olds with a 14-15 or Child Oyster photocard
- 16-17 year olds living in London who are studying full time and have a 16-17 Oyster photocard
- wheelchair users

All other 16-17 year olds with an Oyster photocard and New Deal photocard holders qualify for half adult rate Oyster single fares.

Cash fares are not accepted on buses in the Pay Before You Board area in central London, on bendy buses or on route W7. You must have enough value on your Oyster card to pay as you go or a valid ticket before boarding or buy one from a roadside ticket machine.

Bus Saver

You can buy a book of six Bus Saver tickets at all Ticket Stops and London Travel Information Centres for travel across the entire London bus network. When using Bus Saver tickets you need to board at the front door of the bus, give the Staff receipt part only of the ticket to the driver and retain the top part. They are not valid on trams.

Tram feeder bus services

Valid tram cash single/return tickets can also be used for onward travel, via any interchange point in the Addington area, on tram feeder bus services T31, T32 and T33.

Tram cash single/return tickets can also be bought on tram feeder bus services T31, T32 and T33 for inclusive travel on trams via any interchange point in the Addington area.

Wimbledon

When travelling by tram to Wimbledon, always touch in at the start of your journey and touch out when leaving the station. When travelling by tram from Wimbledon, always touch in at the station gates and again at the Oyster reader on the tram platform before boarding. Do not use the Oyster card reader on the manual gate when exiting the station.
